This year's ACSD conference will take place in Aachen, Germany. The focuses on theoretical and applied research about formal approaches (in a broad sense) to designing computer systems that exhibit concurrent behavior. This year's conference is special because of the co-location with two other conferences (ICPM 2019 and Petri nets 2019) and a special event on Friday June 28 to celebrate the 40-years of Petri net conferences. The distinguished Carl Adam Petri (CAP) lecture will be given by Luca Cardelli and there will be invited talks by Philippos Tsigas and Dirk Fahland (shared with Petri nets).

The conference will take place in the conference area of the Tivoli football stadium close to the city center of Aachen. This beautiful venue will provide a unique atmosphere with great views and excellent conference facilities. In the same week, also the International Conference on Process Mining (ICPM 2019) and the 40th International Conference on Application and Theory of Petri Nets and Concurrency (Petri nets 2019) will take place. Attendees can also join the Petri Net Course, the International Workshop on Petri Nets and Software Engineering, the Algorithms & Theories for the Analysis of Event Data (ATAED 2019) workshop, the tutorial on Model Checking for Petri Nets – From Algorithms to Technology by Karsten Wolf and the tutorial on Model-based Software Engineering for/with Petri Nets by Ekkart Kindler.

Note that papers can still be submitted to the two workshops until March 30th! It is also possible to submit your tool demonstration for Petri Nets/ACSD 2019.
